Who are we?

- We are part of the North Somerset Wildlife Monitoring Project, is co-ordinated by the Bat Conservation Research Lab at the University of the West of England.
- In partnership with North Somerset Council and Avon Wildlife Trust we aim to achieve biodiversity friendly



We need your help!

This is a citizen science project meaning we rely on people like you to collect data.



How it works

- Volunteers will need to select a 1km-square/s and then pick up our bat acoustic detector kit from a Detector Hosting Centre such as this.
- Detectors are then set up in your survey square and left for six nights to record bat calls.
- Once you have finished you just upload your data to our portal and see which bats are living around you!
